Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, OHS will not host an in-person training or webinar for the FY 2021 SHSP PSTCP Application Workshop. Eligible Applicants: Local Units of Government, Non-Governmental Organizations, Quasi-Governmental Organizations and Nonprofit Organizations.

Ineligible Applicants: Applicants located within the geographical boundaries of the St. Louis Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI), which includes (St. Louis City, St. Louis County, Franklin County and Jefferson County). State Agencies are not eligible applicants.
