Ashland presented on the need to extend Perry Avenue. Members

in attendance scored the applications based on a scoring guide provided by MoDOT. Ashland scored as the top priority project for TAC. Both projects are believed to be competitive projects overall.

### **Agenda Item III. Discussion-Governor's Cost Share Program**

Attendees were asked for feedback on the Governor's Cost-Share program. The program is aimed at road and bridge projects that have an economic benefit to the region.

### **Agenda Item IV. MoDOT Central District Report**

- Rescission-At this time the rescission is still set to happen. Each of our counties have a project already lined up so we are in a good position to not lose funds and miss out on projects.
- Rocheport funding-MoDOT is putting together their funding program for the Rocheport bridge. The Infra-grant will cover a chunk of the bridge. Some city and county funds have been pledged toward the bridge to assist in costs as well.

There have been several position changes at MoDOT. Mabelle Watkins is the new Central District Engineer. Jerica Holtsclaw is the new Motor Carrier Director. Lance Taylor is the new Planning and Program Coordinator.
