**Citizen's Guide to Transportation Funding**

MoDOT Transportation Planning Specialist, Mike Henderson gave a brief overview of MoDOT's Citizen Guide to Transportation Funding. Henderson demonstrated how the online sections of the guide works. The online calculator can also show what you are currently contributing in taxes and fees to support the transportation system. He explained transportation is funded from motor fuel taxes, motor vehicle sales taxes and motor vehicle registration and driver license fees. How does MO compare? Missouri is the 7th largest transportation system in the country but ranks 47th in revenue per mile. Missouri fuel tax is one of the lowest in the nation. Almost all of our neighboring 8 states are beating us in investing in transportation.

**2018-2022 STIP - MidMO Region Projects**

David Bock reported a list of 2018-2022 STIP pavement and bridge projects for the Mid-MO region were in the agenda packet. The committee will discuss the prioritization of the Regional Transportation List at the next TAC meeting.
