Agenda Item I, and II. Call to Order

Kenny Kunze called the meeting to order at 3:00 pm. Introductions were made around the room by those in attendance.

Doug Reese motioned to approve the agenda. Gary Jungermann seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

There was a review of the March 22, TAC meeting minutes for any additions or corrections. Doug Reese motioned to approve the minutes. Gary Jungermann seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Agenda Item II. Discussion

FY2018 Transportation Work Program

Ed Siegmund went through the Mid-Missouri Regional Planning Commission Transportation Work Program for the upcoming fiscal year. Mid-MO RPC's transportation work program is divided into 4 categories or tasks- administration, regional transportation plan update, transportation planning activities, and professional development. Mid-MO RPC updated its Regional Transportation Plan in 2016. The plan will be updated annually with relevant information made available through transportation planning and other planning activities conducted as part of the Mid-MO RPC Work Program during the year. In FY18, it is anticipated that the Regional Transportation Plan will undergo minor revisions. Updated information regarding MoDOT's funding capacity, performance measures etc. will be added as appropriate.

Mid-MO RPC will be updating the Public Transit – Human Service Transportation Plan 2017-18, and relevant information from this planning process will be added to the Regional Transportation Plan. Staff will also review our contact list of transportation stakeholders in the Region.

Mr. Siegmund explained that Mid-MO RPC can also provide transportation planning services for individual communities and showed examples of past transportation planning initiatives in Ashland and Holts Summit.

Regional Transportation Needs List

David Bock explained that it is time to begin the annual update to the Regional Transportation Needs List. This process includes removing projects from the current list that have either been completed or have been added to MoDOT's STIP, adding new projects to the list and reevaluating whether current projects should be a high, medium or low priority. Mr. Bock went through the draft changes to the needs list and the group gave input on what changes should be made to the draft needs list.

Agenda Item III. MoDOT Report

Central District Engineer Mike Schupp reported that the Route J/M bridge over U.S. Route 50 will close on Friday, June 2 so the 43-year-old bridge can be replaced. This closure will directly follow the reopening of the Route 50 intersections at Liberty/Shamrock and Lisletown Roads on Thursday, June 1.

Work to replace the Route H bridge over Davis Creek in Callaway County began on Monday, May 15. The bridge is located approximately four miles west of Route 54 in Fulton.

Work will soon begin on replacing the deck and widening the southbound U.S. Route 63 bridge over the Katy Trail in Callaway County. The bridge is located approximately four miles north of Jefferson City. The southbound bridge is expected to close in early to mid-June. At that time, southbound Route 63 traffic will be switched to northbound Route 63, which will carry one lane of traffic in each direction. The project is scheduled to be completed in September.

Plans are also underway to widen Route 124 and Route B between Centralia and Columbia.
