Agenda Item I. Call to order

TAC chair called the meeting to order at 1:35pm. Introductions were made around the room by those in attendance.

Larry Benz made a motion to approve the agenda. Don Baragary seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

There was a review of the September 26th TAC meeting minutes. Larry Benz made a motion to approve the agenda. Don Baragary seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Agenda Item II. Review of TAP Scoring sheet

There are seven categories TAC will be basing their rankings of the TAP applications on. These categories mirror a portion of the categories that MoDot will be using in their review of the applications.

TAC scoring categories and available points are as follows:

- Safety Need and/or Emphasis (10pts.)
- Connectivity to Activity Centers (10pts.)
- ADA Transition Plan/Address Barriers to Access (10pts.)
- Evidence of Public Involvement (5pts.)
- Local/Regional Plan (5pts.)
- Match (10pts.)

All projects presented 25% match, which awarded them 5 points according to MoDot's set point scale for match. (20-24%=0pts, 25-35%=5pts, >35%=10pts.)

Agenda Item III. TAP Presentations and Scoring

Kyle Bruemmer presented for the City of Fulton. The City requested \$400k in TAP funding for road and pedestrian improvements to Business 54, between Collier Lane and Westminster Avenue in Fulton. A turn lane would be added to the center of the highway, currently overhead utility lines would be buried, and ADA compliant sidewalks with integrated storm sewers would be added to both sides of Business 54. This project is near Bartley Public Elementary school.

Don Jenkins presented for the City of Pilot Grove. The City requested \$188k in TAP funding for sidewalk creation and improvement along 4th and Harris St in Pilot Grove. The project would tie into current MoDot upgrades and run ADA compliant sidewalks down Harris Street to St. Joseph Catholic school, then follow 4th Street to Pilot Grove's school and include crossings.

Don Jenkins also presented for the City of Fayette. The City requested \$183k in TAP funding for ADA sidewalk creation and improvement along Church Street in Fayette. This project would fill the gap between existing sidewalks in the central part of town and a set of sidewalks in front of C&R Supermarket. It would also create a crosswalk and connect to the soon-to-be constructed Dollar General that is moving across from the existing supermarket. This would allow for continuous pedestrian access from Central Methodist University Campus to two major shopping centers.

Attendees reported on community activities currently underway within the respective local government.

Agenda Item V. TAP Scoring Tabulation Reported and Final TAP Discussion

Pilot Grove scored as the #1 priority. Fulton scored #2. Fayette scored as a very close #3. There was no discussion and the current rankings were accepted.
